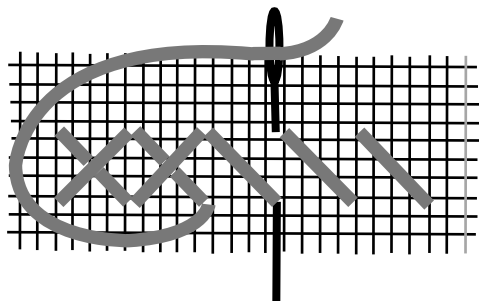

A Short Course In Cross Stitch

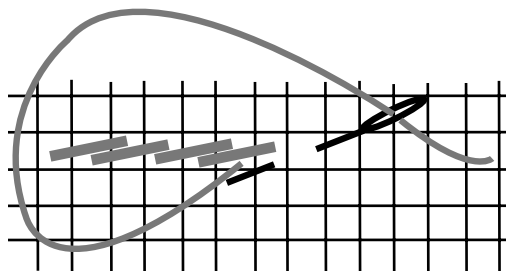
Bring the thread through at the lower right-hand side, insert the needle 1 block up and 1 block to the left and bring out 1 block down, thus forming a half cross, continue in this way to the end of the row. Complete the upper half of the cross as shown.



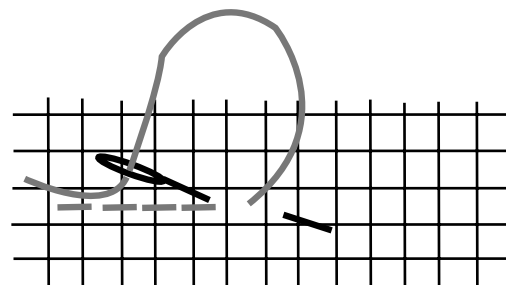
Cross stitch may be worked either from right to left or left to right, but it is important that the upper stroke of all crosses should lie in the same direction.

A Short Course in Running Stitch

Running stitch and back stitch are the same basic stitch, the difference is which side of the fabric you're looking at. Back stitch looks thicker and fuller than running stitch.



Both are a two steps forward and one step back kind of stitch. After coming through the fabric, run the needle across two blocks, then down. Bring the needle back one block and bring it up through the fabric again. Run it two block, then down, and so on.
